DIVISION OF CAPITOL POLICE TO ATTAIN STATE ACCREDITATION

Richmond, VA -

WHAT: The Division of Capitol Police will be recognized at the board meeting of the Virginia Law Enforcement Professional Standards Commission (VLEPSC) for its submission to obtain accreditation.

The Virginia Association of Chiefs of Police and the Virginia Sheriffs Association in partnership with the Department of Criminal Justice Services, created the accrediting body, VLEPSC, for law enforcement agencies in the Commonwealth. The VLEPSC accreditation program is voluntary and open to more than 400 law enforcement agencies in the Commonwealth. Accredited status through the VLEPSC indicates a law enforcement agency is in compliance with all 187 Commission standards.
