
Capitol Police Looking for Persons of Interest in Credit Card Thefts

RICHMOND, VA – On July 8, 2015, the Division responded to a Theft of Credit Cards call at the James Monroe Building located at 101 North 14th Street Richmond, VA. The victim had three (3) credit cards stolen. The credit cards were then used unlawfully to make purchases at the Apple store, Best Buy, and Walgreens located in the Short Pump, Henrico County area. A review of the video surveillance footage from the different stores showed 2 unknown black females driving a black Mercedes e350 coupe with an unknown Pennsylvania registration.

#1 - Black Female, Approximate HGT/5'10", WGT/150lbs, EYES/unknown, HAIR/Black

#2 - Black Female, Approximate HGT/5'7", WGT/130lbs, EYES/unknown, HAIR/Brown
