Arrest Made in Virginia Science Museum Case

RICHMOND, VA – The Division of Capitol Police has made an arrest in the case of the alleged sexual assault that occurred at the Virginia Science Museum on February 14, 2016. Twenty-five year old Evan Bernard Black, who lives in The Fan area of Richmond, was arrested this morning at Capitol Police headquarters and charged with Virginia Code Section 18.2-47, Abduction, a Class 5 Felony punishable by up to 10 years in prison and/or a \$2500 fine. Mr. Black was transported to the Richmond Justice Center, where he is being held without bond pending a preliminary hearing in Richmond General District Court at 8:45 am tomorrow morning. Additional charges are expected. At this time, there is no indication that this case is connected to the Attempted Abduction at the Air & Space Museum in Washington, D.C. on March 3rd.
