Two Division of Capitol Police Officers Step into Sergeant Roles

RICHMOND – The Virginia Division of Capitol Police is proud to announce the promotion of two officers to the rank of sergeant. Sergeant Kevin Jones and Sergeant Eric Lynch were officially promoted by Colonel John T. McKee, following a competitive selection process.

Sgt. Jones brings more than 13 years of law enforcement experience and holds a master's degree in criminal justice from Walden University. He joined the Division of Capitol Police in 2022 and has embraced a role in the development and training of current personnel. Sgt. Jones holds multiple certifications through the Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services, including general instructor, Narcan instructor, defensive tactics instructor, ALERRT instructor, field training officer, among others. In addition, he has trained to provide executive protection to key government officials. Sgt. Jones has been a significant asset of the division, earning Rookie of the Year in 2023 and the Award of Excellence in 2024.

Sgt. Lynch joined the Division of Capitol Police in 2023 after eight years of distinguished service in the United States Marine Corps, where he attained the rank of sergeant. Upon joining the division, Sgt. Lynch became a certified field training officer, playing a key role in preparing and developing the division's newest officers.
