Capitol Police arrest 2 for trespassing

RICHMOND – The Virginia Division of Capitol Police arrested two people Saturday for trespassing outside the Executive Mansion.

The two men were outside the main gate of the governor's residence, yelling toward the building shortly after 12:30 p.m., when Capitol Police officers approached them, identified themselves and told the pair they needed a permit to protest inside the grounds of Capitol Square. Police asked the two to voluntarily leave, and when they refused, they were taken into custody.

Neil E. Wolfe, 51, of the 3900 block of Fenwick Street in Richmond, and Mark A. Sfeir, 23, of the 700 block of Merrimans Lane in Winchester, were taken to the city jail and processed on one count each of trespassing, a misdemeanor.
