Woman sought for threatening messages left at Capitol Square

RICHMOND – Virginia Capitol Police have obtained a warrant charging a woman with leaving threatening telephone messages at Capitol Square.

Cheryl L. Easter was named in the warrant obtained Tuesday on a single count of use of profane, threatening or indecent language over public airways, a misdemeanor.

Easter, 59, is described as 5 feet tall, weighing 113 pounds with brown eyes and black hair. She is believed to be living in the Petersburg area.

Capitol Police said Easter left five voicemails Monday at the Supreme Court of Virginia in which she threatened to use a gun to kill people at a post office.
